PEMAKLUMAN BERKENAAN PERLAKSANAAN PENUH KEPERLUAN MENGEMUKAKAN LAPORAN PERLEPASAN KARBON (*ENVIRONMENTAL PRODUCT DECLARATION*) BAGI PERMOHONAN *CERTIFICATE OF APPROVAL (COA)* MELALUI SISTEM EPERMIT

Dengan segala hormatnya perkara di atas dan surat terdahulu rujukan no: LPIPM: SPN/BPKB/01/01/4 (16) bertarikh 25 September 2025 adalah dirujuk.

2. CIDB telah menetapkan di dalam surat tersebut tarikh pelaksanaan keperluan mengemukakan Laporan Perlepasan Karbon (*Environmental Product Declaration – EPD*) bagi produk panjang besi dan keluli terpilih iaitu **Bars, Cold Drawn Bars, Wire Rods dan Wire Products**. adalah bermula 1 Oktober 2025.

3. Berikutan dengan itu, bagi mana-mana pengimport yang masih dalam proses mendapatkan laporan tersebut, pihak CIDB telah memberikan kelonggaran untuk mengemukakan *Letter of Undertaking (Lampiran A)* bagi membolehkan produk-produk yang telah tiba di pintu masuk dan mempunyai sijil Perakuan Pematuhan Standard (PPSi) yang sah untuk permohonan *Certificate of Approval (COA)*.

4. Walaubagaimanapun, penggunaan *Letter of Undertaking* ini akan ditamatkan penggunaannya pada **30 Jun 2026**. Mana-mana pengimport yang masih gagal mengemukakan EPD selepas dari tarikh tersebut **dilarang untuk mengimport** produk-produk tersebut dan sekiranya konsainan tersebut tiba di pintu masuk negara ia perlu dihantar semula ke negara asal atau mana-mana negara lain. Tiada sebarang pertimbangan lain akan dibuat dan CIDB tidak akan bertanggungjawab ke atas mana-mana kerugian yang ditanggung oleh pengimport akibat dari kegagalan mematuhi arahan ini.

CIDB may take any disciplinary actions to suspend or blacklist our company from future application of COA. We make this undertaking in good faith and affirm our commitment to full compliance with MITI and CIDB regulatory framework.
